• IMS Class Rules and  
Regulations  
• ORC Championship Rules for  
the Offshore Classes  
• ORC Special Regulations  
governing offshore racing for  
category 3 with life rafts on board  
compulsory  
• IMS 600 Class Rules  
• The Notice of Race  
• The Sailing Instructions  
In the event of a conflict between  
any of the above rules and/or  
regulations and the Sailing  
Instructions, the Sailing  
Instructions shall prevail.

6-EVENT CLASSIFICATION  
AND ADVERTISING  
The regatta is designated  
category C under RRS Appendix  
1 - ISAF Advertising Code,  
Regulation 20.

7-JURY  
An international jury will be  
appointed in accordance with  
rule 70.4 and Appendix M. All  
decisions of the international jury  
shall be final.

The entry fee is 550 EURO and  
has to be paid to  
NORDDEUTSCHER REGATTA  
VEREIN. Entries shall be made  
on the official entry form and  
shall be received, completed in  
full, by NORDDEUTSCHER  
REGATTA VEREIN not later  
than July 15<sup>th</sup> 2005. In Alteration  
of RRS 78.2 valid IMS-rating  
certificates shall be submitted  
with the entry. In exceptional  
cases the Rating Certificate may  
be submitted not later than  
August, 19<sup>th</sup> 2005 at 9:00 hrs.  
Otherwise the yacht will be  
scored DNS.

10-RACING AREA

11-REGISTRATION  
Registration formalities shall be  
completed at the Race office by  
19.00 hrs on 20<sup>th</sup> August, 2005,  
submitting the crew list with  
the names and weight of each  
crew member. All crew weights  
shall be verified using the scales  
provided by the Organising  
Authority.

12-INSPECTION  
All yachts have to be available  
for inspection acc. to ORC  
championship rules Nos 5.4, 6.1  
and 10. Pre-Race Inspections

will be held on 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> of  
August. Timetable for inspections  
will be displayed at registration  
desk not later than 19 August  
09.00 hrs. Sail Limitation acc. to  
ORC championship rules 10.1  
and IMS regulation 205. ("one  
set of sails plus one spare  
mainsail")

13-SCORING  
According to IMS 600 Class  
Rules  
• the Inshore-TMF will be used  
for the Windward/Leeward races  
• the Offshore-TMF will be used  
for the Offshore Race.  
• the offshore race will be scored  
in two parts acc. to 6.1 ORC  
Championship rules  
• Windward/Leeward coefficient  
1  
• Offshore coefficient 1,25  
At least one Offshore Race and  
four Windward/Leeward races  
have to be sailed to constitute a  
World Championship.

14-TROPHIES AND PRIZES  
Perpetual Trophy for the World  
Championship will be awarded.  
Prizes for the three top scored  
yachts of the series. Special  
Prizes: ROLEX Chronometer for  
the owner or helmsman of the  
winning yacht.
