► **1-ORGANIZING AUTHORITY**

The NORDDEUTSCHER REGATTA VEREIN
in co-operation with the International Dragon
Association and the German Dragon
Association is pleased to invite Dragon sailors
to take part in the Hanseatic Lloyd Dragon
World Championship and Dragon World
Week within the ROLEX BALTIC WEEK at the

► **2-RULES**

The race will be governed by the rules as
defined in the ISAF RRS (2005-2008), the
International Dragon Class Rules, the
Dragon World Championship Rules, this
Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
In the event of conflict the Sailing
Instructions shall prevail. The official lan-
guage of the Regatta is English. The crew
weight restriction in Class Rule 13.3 shall
apply.

► **3-ADVERTISING**

The Regatta is designated category A under ISAF Advertising Code Regulation 20 (Advertising pursuant to Regulation 20.3.1 [d] [i] maybe required).

► **4-ELIGIBILITY**

4.1 The regulations 6 to 16 of the IDA Dragon World Championship Rules shall apply.*

4.2 ISAF eligibility requirements under RRS appendix 2 shall apply.

4.3 Only International Dragon Class Yachts, which hold valid registration/measurement certificates, shall compete.

4.4 Owners shall be current members of their national Dragon Association.

4.5 All entries have to be validated by the corresponding national Dragon Association prior to submission.*

► **5-ENTRIES**

5.1 Each national Dragon Association concerned shall inform the German Dragon Association of the number of boats and names of helmsmen that have qualified to participate from its country.*

5.2 A formal entry from each yacht shall be submitted on the enclosed format, together with a copy of the yacht's valid registration measurement certificate and the entry fee of € 550 (Dragon World Week € 350) payable by bank account see NOR 5.3. The fee includes craneage and berthing in the marina for the duration of the regatta as well as 3 tickets per boat for the Crew Dinner and the Gala Dinner.

Entries and entry fees shall be received prior to 15th June (Dragon World Week 15th July, after that: late entry fee is plus 50 %).

5.4 Upon receipt and validation of the entry a confirmation will be sent together with travel and accommodation information, launch area and times, general weather and tidal information and the sail measurement form.

► **6-MEASUREMENT**

6.1 Measurement of boats and sails will take place prior to the commencement of racing on 19th August 09.00-18.00 and 20th August 09.00-18.00 according to the stipulation of the IDA Technical Committee. In addition the organizers reserve the right to conduct measurement checks before, during or after any race.

6.2 Yachts shall not present any unmeasured sails for registration and measurement.

6.3 A maximum of eight (8) sails per yacht may be submitted for measurement checks.

6.4 Yachts shall not use any sail(s) other than the eight sails submitted for measurement except with prior written permission of the International Jury, and then only in exceptional circumstances.

► **8-COURSES**

Races will be sailed on windward/leeward courses (leeward gate) in the Bay of Neustadt.

► **9-INTERNATIONAL JURY**

An international jury will be appointed in accordance with RRS 89 (c) from which there shall be no appeal.

► **10-SCORING**

The bonus points scoring system in accordance with appendix A4.1 will apply except that the A4.2 is amended. A boat that did not start, did not finish, retired after finishing or was disqualified shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats confirmed at registration. A boat disqualified shall be scored additional points equal to 10% of the number of boats confirmed at registration, fractions being raised to the next highest whole number. Minimum four races shall be completed to complete the series. If only four races are completed, all will count. If more than four races are completed there will be one discard. Ties will be in accordance with A8.

The winning boat represented by the helmsman shall have temporary possession of the Royal Hellenic Cup for a period of two years. Medals will be presented to the helmsman and crew of the first, second and third placed yachts. Special Prize: a Rolex Chronometer for the owner or helmsman of the winning yacht. Other prizes may be awarded.

► **11.2-TROPHY AND PRIZES**
DRAGON WORLD WEEK

The winning boat represented by the winning helmsman shall win the NRV Dragon World Week Cup donated by Gunter Persiehl. Special Prize: a Rolex Chronometer for the owner or helmsman of the winning yacht. Other prizes may be awarded.

► **12-SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**
AND REGISTRATION

The Sailing Instructions and the list of competitors will be given to each entrant on registration.

► **13-LIABILITY AND INSURANCE**

13.1 A boat is entirely responsible for her own safety, whether afloat or ashore and nothing, whether in the Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions or anywhere else, reduces this responsibility.

13.2 It is for the boat to decide whether she is fit to sail in the conditions she will find herself in. By going to sea the boat confirms that she is fit for those conditions and her crew is competent to sail and compete in them.

13.3 The boat is required to hold adequate insurance and in particular to hold insurance against third party claims in the sum of at least € 1,2 million from the time of arrival to the time of departure from the regatta.

Valid certificates have to be carried with and may be inspected.

13.4 Nothing done by the organizers can reduce the responsibility of the boat, nor will it make the organizers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred as a result of the boat taking part in the racing. The organizers include everyone helping to run the racing and the event and include the organizing authority, the race committee, the principal race officer, patrol boats and beach masters.

13.5 The provision of patrol boats does not relieve the boat of her responsibility.

13.6 The fact that the race committee conducts inspections of the boat, does not reduce the responsibilities of the boat set out in the paragraph.

13.7 Competitors are also advised to arrange their own personal accident insurance.

► 9-RULES

The swan race will be governed by:

1.0 ISAF Racing Rules for 2005 – 2008, latest edition of the DSV.

1.1 Special regulations of the DSV.

1.2 Class rules for measurement, equipment and propulsion.

1.3 This Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

1.4 Special regulations of the ORC.

2.0 The helmsman of each participating boat shall have a certificate of competence from the DSV, or as may required by her / his national authority valid for the race area.

3.0 The Sailing Instructions may partly alter the RRS and this Notice of Race. In case of conflict as to language and / or interpretation the English text shall prevail.

4.0 German law shall prevail.

5.0 In alteration of RRS 44.2 there will be a 360°-turn for keelboats.

6.0 Changes to the RRS or the Sailing Instructions will only be made in writing and will be posted on the official notice boards in front of the Race Office.

► **10-ADVERTISING**

Advertising for the SWAN RACE is permitted according to ISAF advertising codex category C.

► **11-IDENTIFICATION**

1.0 In alteration of RRS 77 the class sign, national letters and sail number declared with the entry shall appear on the sails. In case of missing or wrong sail numbers or by violation of the class rules the yacht shall be excluded in alteration of the RRS 63.1 without a jury decision.

2.0 RRS appendix G1 applies only for main sails and largest genoas. In all other sails national abbreviations may be used according to the rules before 1st April 1997.

3.0 The yachts shall fly the number burgee of their start on the backstay.

► **12-MEASUREMENT**

1.0 There will be no initial measurement.

2.0 In alteration of RRS 78.2 all measurement certificates have to be submitted together with the entry. In exceptional cases the measurement certificate may be submitted not later than 19th August, 18.00 in

the Race Office. After this point of time the yacht may be scored DNC or DNS.

3.0 Yachts without a valid measurement certificate are not eligible to start. Foreign yachts shall hold and submit a valid measurement certificate issued by their national sailing federation.

4.0 The sails (Main, G1, Spinnaker) have to be measured.

5.0 The race committee or its commissioner will conduct control measurements of the yachts and control the compliance of the class rules, the equipment and the observation of RRS appendix G.

► **13-CREW LIST**

The crew list has to be presented not later than 19th August, 18.00 in the Race Office.

14-SAFETY INFORMATION

► **1.0** The organizers and their representatives do not accept any liability for loss of life or property, personal injury or damage to property caused by or in connection with the event.

2.0 Concerning the safety and equipment all participating boats shall comply with the newest "ORC Special Regulations für die Ausrüstung und Sicherheit seegehender Segelyachten", edition of the Kreuzer-Abteilung of DSV.

3.0 These races are rated category 4 in conformity with their class rules. The long distance race shall be rated category 3.

2.0 The Sailing Instructions may partly alter the RRS and this Notice of Race.

3.0 In case of differences concerning language and/or interpretation the English text shall prevail.

4.0 Changes to these rules or the Sailing Instructions will only be made in writing and posted on the official notice board near the Race Office.

► **12-ADVERTISING**

The German Open is designated as a "category C event".

► **13-IDENTIFICATION**

1.0 In alteration of RRS 77 the class insignia, national letters and sail numbers declared with the entry shall appear on the sails.

2.0 National letters and sail numbers need not be displayed in headsails. This alters RRS appendix G1.3 (e).

3.0 If the organizing authority supplies sails to all competitors these sails must be used instead of the competitor's regular sails.

4.0 Yachts may be required to fly the flag of an event sponsor from their backstay while racing, if such a flag is provided.

► **14-MEASURING & CONTROLS**

1.0 A rating measurement certificate or other class documents which make evident that the yacht complies with the class rules must be available.

2.0 There can be control measurements of sails on boats chosen at random. Each X-79 crew must be weighed. We reserve the right to control safety equipment and observance of class rules during the event.

► **15-SCORING**

The Low Point System, RRS appendix A 4 will apply. Nine races are scheduled. Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series. When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When from 5 to 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. When 9 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores. This changes RRS appendix A 2.

► **16-PRIZES**

Deutschland Cup awarded to the winners.

Half-model-Cup for the best German X-79.

Point prizes will be awarded for each group of up to three boats.

Special Prize: a Rolex Chronometer for the owner or helmsman of the winning yacht.

► **17-JURY**

A international jury will be appointed.
