1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITIES & EVENTS:

1.1. All the events described below are organized by the following locations with their organizing authorities in conjunction with the Finnish Offshore Racing Association (Avomeripurjehtijat) and Estonian Yachting Union (EYU):

2. RULES

- 2.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) for 2017–2020 of the World Sailing.
- 2.2. All other rules applying will be defined with each event' Notice of Race.

3. ADVERTISING

- 3.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

4. ELIGIBILITY

- 4.1. The regattas are open to all boats with a valid ORC measurement certificate.
- 4.2. Each event' eligibility prescriptions will define.

5. ENTRY

- 5.1. Eligible boats will register for each event, using the system described in that event' NOR.

6. GROUPS, FEES, SCHEDULE, MEASUREMENTS, SAILING INSTRUCTIONS, VENUE, THE COURSES, PENALTY SYSTEM, SUPPORT BOATS, BERTHING, HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS, DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS, RADIO COMMUNICATION, AND INSURANCE.

6.1. Each event' NOR will define.

7. SCORING

7.1. For the Results of the FINEST Offshore Series:

7.1.1. The Low Point System of the World Sailing RRS Appendix A will apply;

7.1.2. One ranking will be compiled, even if there are two (2) groups at the events;

7.1.3. A boat attending the single event and scored DNS, DNC, DNF, RET in single race, will be scored one (1) additional point more than the number of boats that completed the single event' registration;

7.1.4. A boat not competing at a single event, will be assigned to each single race held during that event one (1) additional point than the number of boats that have completed their registration for that event. This will change RRS Appendix A9.

7.1.5. The Results of the Series will be calculated by adding all the races completed in the individual events (including the races discarded for the single event results). The worst scores will be discarded as follows:

1st discard: when the 6th race will be completed;

2nd discard: when the 12th race will be completed;

3rd discard: when the 18th race will be completed;

that correspond to the completion of the maximum races planned for the Series.

7.1.6. The offshore leg' result of the Baltic Offshore Week shall not be discarded.

7.1.7. DNS, DNC, DNF, RET are first priority of discarding races in the Series.

8. PRIZES

8.1. The first three (3) teams of the Series will be awarded with the trophies.

9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

9.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
